SHORT SYNOPSIS

A dark, almost brutal film, pierced by shards of humor and flickers of abstract hope.

From the wreckage of a buddy comedy rises something stranger: a story that fractures midway into an existential revenge thriller — burning forward with the inevitability of the sun's passage across the sky.

LONG SYNOPSIS

A dark, almost brutal film built on the ruins of a buddy comedy — blending absurd humor with unexpected, abstract hope.

Mikael, a man working at a stone quarry, is forced to leave work mid-day because of severe pain in his legs. Soon, there's a knock at his door: Move — a former friend, or perhaps just an old acquaintance — appears unexpectedly. His life has collapsed under the weight of inhalants and fragmented hallucinations. Move speaks of recurring visions: walls transforming into pixels, and a song playing in his head — one that doesn't exist.

As the afternoon stretches into evening, a neighbor arrives, mistakes Move for Mikael, and asks for help carrying a package. The following moment inside turns strangely intimate: a bright light therapy lamp burns in the darkness, a phone plays the song Forever Alone, and Move flees in confusion — realizing he came without shoes.

The night spirals into drugs, strobe lights, and despair. Boundaries begin to dissolve.

Morning arrives with a sharp, penetrating light, as if from another reality. The story begins again: now the main character is Esko, a man who looks like Mikael but seems to inhabit a parallel space. He is being searched for by his cousin and brother — who resembles the earlier neighbor this time. Reality fractures into identical faces, recurring moments, and images that foreshadow violence.

The search culminates in a remote forest clearing, where Osku — another echo of Move — delivers an absurd monologue to the sun before his annihilation. Blood seeps into the ground.

Finally, the cousin and John sit in a car in a middle of a rain. Lightning flashes. In the glove compartment, they find a photograph of Esko. Why it's there, nobody knows. The rain intensifies, moisture blurs the view.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

This film was never entirely made, it was allowed to happen. From the beginning, I wanted to see what would emerge if control were removed: no script, no crew, no boundary between the film and the world. We worked only with what existed—weather, exhaustion, coincidence, the shifting moods of the day. Out of these fragments, the story grew on its own.

Working with non-actors was essential. As they didn't imitate emotion; they inhabited it. Their gestures, frustrations, and silences became the film's language. My task was to listen, to respond rather than direct.

This film is a record of what happens when control dissolves and something else begins to speak through the cracks. My role was to witness and assemble what was already unfolding. So the film is essentially a collaboration with chance.

BIOGRAPHY

Matti HARJU studied MA in Directing Fiction at the National Film and Television School UK and received an MFA from the Finnish Academy of Fine Arts.

His film school shorts and self-produced films were presented in festivals such as Locarno, Rotterdam, Doclisboa, AFI Fest Los Angeles, BFI London, Torino, Edinburgh, 25FPS, Clermont-Ferrand and Kurzfilmtage Oberhausen. He has held solo shows at Gallery Sinne twice.

Nox (2026) is his second feature film.
